

How to read the Class Schedule

CRN = **C**ourse **R**eference **N**umber. The CRN is needed to register.

Click on the title for a description of the course and its pre or co requisites.

Indicates the day(s) of the week the course meets. R means the course meets only on Thursday. TR means the course meets on Tuesday and Thursday.

Click on the instructor's name to see his or her full name and contact information.
