A major in Digital Cinema from SOU offers visual storytellers the creative skills, technical immersion, and faculty mentoring they need to turn their ideas into compelling moving images in preparation for a wide array of media-making careers. Experiential classes give students ample on-set opportunities to put their understanding into action in a supportive environment where failure is celebrated as an integral stage of the learning process. We encourage our student filmmakers to chart new territory and create courageously, challenging themselves to push the boundaries of the possible.

Our small class sizes promote camaraderie and community among students, planting the seeds of an essential professional network and sharpening skills in collaboration and communication. Students engage in frequent peer feedback and peer mentoring, learning as much from one another as from their faculty, and develop the advanced group problem-solving skills necessary to a career in professional production.

CAREER OPTIONS

Career pathways for the graduating Digital Cinema student include entry-level crew positions in film and television production or post-production services, creative story development and screenwriting, or graduate study in film and video, as well as opportunities in video and broadcast journalism, advertising and marketing, corporate and non-profit communications, event videography, independent media production, emerging and virtual media production, and film festival programming.
