### PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Education Studies major is a bachelor’s degree program that prepares graduates to work in a variety of careers in education. The Education Studies program has a licensure pathway in which qualified seniors can earn an Oregon Preliminary teaching license for the elementary grades. The Education Studies major also has a degree pathway which results in a bachelor’s degree without a teaching license.

### CAREER OPTIONS

Education Studies degree with licensure graduates can teach in public elementary schools and private schools. Education Studies degree-only graduates can work as teachers in some private schools. They can also work in museums, youth camps and specialized centers such as Science Works. Graduates in Education Studies also work in supportive roles with licensed teachers in public schools. These students often earn their teaching license as part of a graduate program (MAT).
