

Group Choice



The Group Choice activity allows users to self-enroll in a group—no more passing around sign-up sheets and manually assigning people to their chosen group!

The first step in using this feature is to <u>create groups</u>. Note: If you intend to have learners involved in more than one kind of group (e.g., projects and small group discussions), see these instructions for <u>creating</u> "groupings" to manage multiple sets of groups.

Once your groups are set up, you're ready to add a group choice activity.


- 1. Turn editing on in your course.
- 2. Choose **Group choice** from the **Add an activity or resource** menu.


 Group Choice module allows students to enroll themselves in a group within a course. The teacher can select which groups students can chose from and the maximum number of students allowed in each group.


- 3. Enter a title for the choice.
- 4. Provide instructions in the **Description** textbox.




5. In the Miscellaneous settings area, adjust the settings to meet your needs. Note that you can permit users to enroll in multiple groups. If you want to restrict group membership to a specific number of learners, enable the Limit the number of responses allowed option, set the General limitation to the desired number, and click on Apply to all groups.




6. In the **Groups** area, select the groups (below left) or grouping (below right) from which you would like students to choose and click on the **add** button provided.





- Limit learners to a specific time period for responding if you wish.
- Adjust all other settings using regular Moodle protocols and Save changes.




The image at right illustrates how your group choice link will appear on the main course page.

Opening the link will display a list of the groups you have designated for the choice. Note the links highlighted here that toggle between showing descriptions for the groups (if any) and displaying a list of group members (if the settings allow).

Click on the View # responses link in the upper right corner to display the choices that users have made (see illustration next page).
