

From time to time, grades can become "overridden" in a Moodle grade book, preventing auto calculation of scores or blocking a score from being displayed. If a grade item score, category or course total is not correct or is not being updated, check to see if the score background is a light brown color. In Figure 2 below, for instance, all but one of the Category totals have been overridden.

To clear the override:

1. Click on the "View" tab, then click on "**Grader report.**"
2. "**Turn editing on**" at the top right corner of the page.

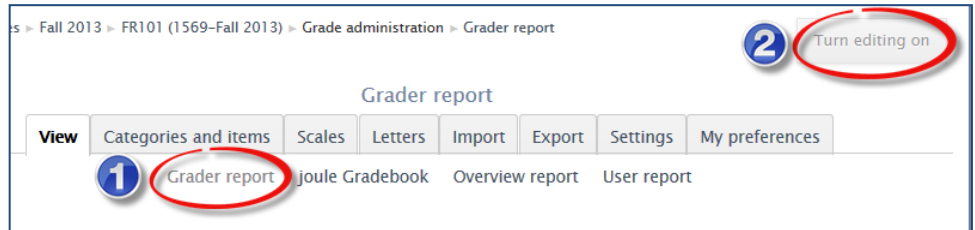


Figure 1: Grader Report View

3. Scroll over to see the item, category or course totals where the scores are shaded.
4. Click on the **Edit grade** icon (pencil/gear) next to any grade that needs to be recalculated (Figure 2).

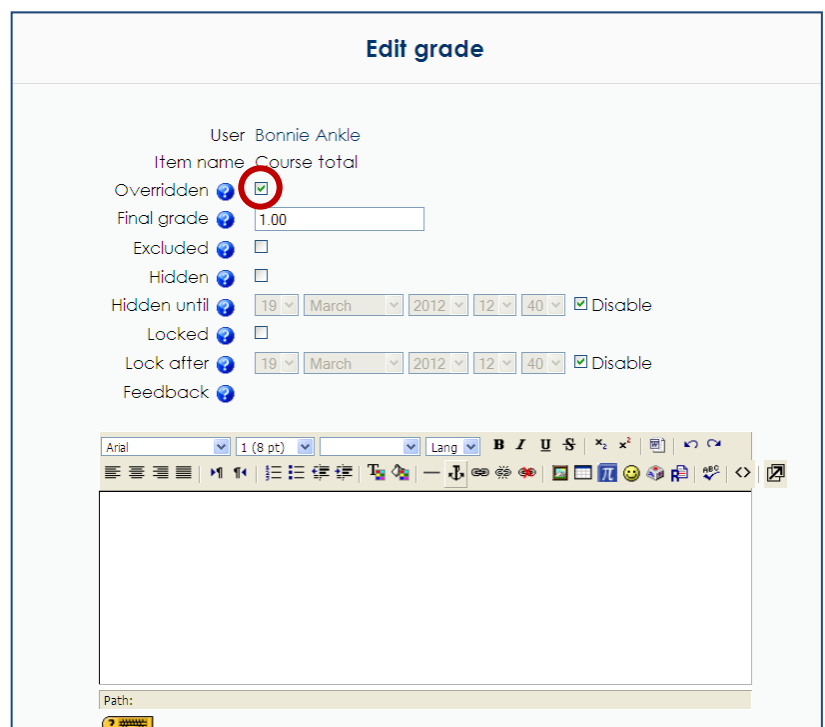


Figure 3: Edit Item View

5. In the **Edit grade** page, remove the check next to **Overridden** (Figure 3).
6. Click on "Save changes."
7. Repeat steps 3-6 for each additional item or total that needs to be cleared.

Moodle will recalculate the total for each student whose grade is cleared.
