Checklist For Adding An Elementary Multiple Subjects Endorsement
To An Existing Oregon Teaching License

In order to gain admission into SOU Graduate Studies and the Endorsement only program, candidates must:

1. Hold a current Oregon teaching license.
2. Have a cumulative GPA for the last 90 undergraduate quarter credits (60 semester credits) that is 2.5 or above.
3. Pass Subtests I and II of the “Elementary Education” exam through orela.nesinc.com. Request to have your test scores reported to SOU.
4. Apply through the SOU Admissions Office at <http://www.sou.edu/admissions/graduate/gr-apply.html> for Graduate Admission. Please note that the form, the \$60 admission fee and all official transcripts should be sent to the Admissions Office, not the School of Education. Persons who have previously been officially admitted and attended as SOU post-baccalaureate or graduate master’s students in Education but have not attended the quarter immediately prior will need to file a Re-Enrollment form (available at the Enrollment Services Center, 541 552-6600).

After gaining admission:

Program Completion:

- _ Enroll in and complete all coursework designated for “Elementary Multiple Subjects Competencies” coursework at SOU.
- _____ After successfully completing the courses above, enroll in the Supervised Practicum and Work Sample course (ED 409 OR ED 509) by Irregular Registration.

Adding the Endorsement to your License:

- _____ When you have completed all of the above, contact the Licensure Specialist at licensure@sou.edu to request an institutional recommendation to Oregon TSPC for the new endorsement.
- _____ Submit a complete eLicensure application to Oregon TSPC at Oregon.gov/tspc, including an official SOU transcript.
