

Prerequisite Coursework for Admission to the MAT Program: DRAMA Endorsement

General Admission Requirements for ALL Single Subject Areas

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters documenting two separate, successful experiences working with groups of children or adolescents. Experiences in public schools are preferred, and experiences working with students at the middle and high school ages are recommended.

Bachelor's Degree

Program participants must have a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university in a field appropriate to the specialty endorsement.

Grade Point Average

Applicants should have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the most recent 90 quarter or 60 semester hours of undergraduate work and a 3.0 for courses completed in the selected endorsement area. Applicants who have a GPA lower than 3.0 may apply for post-baccalaureate admission.

Requirements Specific to the DRAMA Endorsement

Degree Major

Applicants to the MAT program in Drama must hold a baccalaureate degree with a major in Theatre (or coursework equivalent to a major in Theatre).

Required Coursework in Drama

The ideal candidate will have satisfied the following course requirements:

- Script Analysis (4 credits)
- One class in two of the following (8 credits): Stagecraft, Stage Lighting, Costume Crafts
- Acting (4 credits)
- Stage Management (4 credits)
- Theatre Production (4 credits)
- Theatre History (4 credits)
- Directing (4 credits)
- One class in two of the following (8 credits): Scene Design, Lighting Design, Costume Design, Sound Design
- Upper division Theatre History and/or Theatre Literature (8 credits)
