

Elementary/Multiple Subjects Admission Requirements for the MAT Program

General Admission Requirements

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters documenting two separate, successful experiences working with groups of children. Experiences in public schools are preferred, and experiences working with students at the elementary school ages are recommended.

Bachelor's Degree

Program participants must have a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university. Applicants are encouraged to have a major that is a significant part of an elementary school curriculum, e.g., English, Math, science, or social science.

Grade Point Average

Applicants should have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the most recent 90 quarter or 60 semester hours of undergraduate work. Applicants who have a GPA lower than 3.0 may apply for post-baccalaureate admission.

Course Requirements

- Math 211, 212, 213
- 9-12 quarter credits of Social Science with at least one course in History, one course in Geography, and one course in behavioral science (Psychology, Anthropology, Sociology)
- 9-12 quarter credits of Language Arts with at least one course in Writing, one in Communication, and one in English literature
- 9-12 quarter credits of Science with at least one biological science course (Biology, Botany, Zoology, Anatomy/Physiology) and one physical science course (Chemistry, Physics, Geology, Astronomy)
