## **Application Information**

Southern Oregon University offers a graduate program leading to the Master in Interdisciplinary Studies. Prospective students identify a major program of study and then select minor areas from other departments or programs. Students develop a program of study that demonstrates focus and direction appropriate to advanced academic work. Students complete a thesis or non-thesis project option, and oral defense.

#### **Primary and Secondary Areas of Concentration:**

Given the highly customized nature of the MIIS program, it is best to contact the Program Coordinator about areas of study that could serve as a fit for your interests. Currently, our students are taking graduate classes in the following areas: psychology, sociology, anthropology, education, environmental studies, health, outdoor leadership, theater, communication, and business. Please contact the Program Coordinator to determine your fit.

Applications are accepted on a rolling admission basis, and students have the option to start our program any quarter.

All students must apply to both Southern Oregon University for Graduate Admissions (http://www.sou.edu/admissions/graduate/) and to the Master in Interdisciplinary Studies degree program (http://www.sou.edu/miis/index.html). Requirements are noted on the next page.

  - a. A minimum 3.0 GPA in the last 90 quarter units or 60 semester hours is required for graduate admission.
  - b. Applicants who previously attended SOU do not have to order official SOU transcripts, as we will already have access to this information.

Application materials will be evaluated according to the professional judgment of faculty concerning the applicant's suitability for the Master in Interdisciplinary Studies program and the availability of faculty and programs to meet the student's goals.

**Two Letters of Recommendation:** Must be submitted to the MIIS Program Coordinator using the Letter of Recommendation Form included in this packet. We advise that you request your letters at least two months before the application deadline. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all letters have reached the MIIS Graduate Program Coordinator.

**Missing File Items:** Applicants who submit their application before March 15 will be notified if any information is missing from their files. It is the applicant's responsibility to check on the completeness of her/his file, to contact sources, and to keep the MIIS Program Coordinator informed of any changes of address, phone number or email.
