# Academic Robes and Regalia

The history of academic dress dates back to the Middle Ages when many of the scholars were also clerics and wore the robes of their monastic orders. In 1321, the University of Cambridge adopted specific styles and color combinations for its faculties. American colleges and universities desired to adopt a standard code of academic dress. At a conference held at Columbia University in 1895, representatives from various institutions adopted a code and regulations governing academic dress for colleges and universities in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council on Education

The regalia worn today are traditional, and their colors, trimmings, and patterns represent the degree, the field of learning, and the institution which conferred that degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The rear part of the oblong shape is square cut, and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet, and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive to the degree.

The hood also tells a story. The type of degree (Bachelor's, Master's, Doctor's) is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape than the others. The color of the velvet edging indicates the field of learning, and the colors of the lining designate the school which conferred the degree. The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, also indicates the field of study and is gold for those with doctor's degrees.

# **Greetings from the Southern Oregon University Board of Trustees**

## **BILL THORNDIKE**

### **Chair, Southern Oregon University Board of Trustees**

Bill Thorndike operates his family business, Medford Fabrication, a custom steel fabrication company that has been in operation for over 70 years. Mr. Thorndike currently serves on the boards of Southern Oregon University, Oregon Business Council, Regence-Oregon BlueCross Blue Shield, Crater Lake National Park Trust, Southern Oregon Regional Economic Development, Inc., Oregon Economic Forum, Philanthropy Northwest, and the Northwest Health Foundation. He has served on a number of Oregon boards and commissions, including the Port of Portland, The Oregon Community Foundation, Asante Health System and the Portland Branch of the San Francisco Federal Reserve Bank.

Mr. Thorndike is a 1972 graduate of Medford Senior High, and graduated in 1976 from Lewis & Clark College with Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. His honors include the SOLV / Tom McCall Leadership Award and the Glenn Jackson Leadership Award from Willamette University. A third-generation Rogue Valley resident, he resides in rural Jackson County with his wife Angela Littlefield, an equestrian judge.

## **Commencement Speaker**

### **WINONA LADUKE**

Winona LaDuke is a prominent Native American environmentalist and activist who twice ran for vice president on a Green Party ticket headed by Ralph Nader. She was raised largely in Ashland and her mother – noted Oregon painter Betty LaDuke—was a member of SOU’s Art faculty for 32 years.

Ms. LaDuke—the author of six books—is a rural development economist and author working on issues of indigenous economics, food and energy policy. She was a co-founder, and board co-chair of the Indigenous Women’s Network for 15 years, and maintains a significant role in international advocacy for indigenous people—including numerous presentations at United Nations forums.

She currently lives on the White Earth reservation in northern Minnesota and is executive director of Honor the Earth (HtE), a nonprofit that supports indigenous environmental justice. LaDuke co-founded the organization in 1993 with the folk-rock duo the Indigo Girls.

She was inducted into the National Women’s Hall of Fame in 2007, in recognition of her leadership and commitment to her community. She was named one of Time Magazine’s 50 most promising leaders under the age of 40 in 1994; received the Thomas Merton Award in 1996 for her devotion to justice; and in 1998 she shared the Ms. Magazine Women of the Year award with the Indigo Girls.

LaDuke received her Bachelor’s degree in Economics from Harvard University and her Master’s degree in Community Economic Development from Antioch University. She also attended one year in the Community Fellows Program at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

She became a high school principal on the White Earth Reservation, where she became active in Native American and women’s issues. She helped found the Indigenous Women’s Network in 1985, and four years later established the White Earth Land Recovery Project, which has bought back more than 1,200 acres of former reservation land from non-Natives and held it in a conservation trust for the Anishinaabe Tribe.

Her Honor the Earth organization played an active role in the year-long Dakota Access Pipeline protests, which ended in February when National Guard troops cleared protesters from the site.

## **Student Speaker**

### **DANTE FUMAGALLI '17**

Dante Fumagalli will graduate with a Bachelor of Arts in English, with a minor in Art History. Throughout his time at Southern Oregon University, he has worked at the Schneider Museum of Art, where he has coordinated educational programming for the past year. His experience at the Schneider helped him to earn an internship last summer at the Museum of Modern Art in New York City in their Education Department. Next year, he will be returning to New York to pursue a Master of Art in Art History at Hunter College. Dante says that he is very excited to be taking this next step in his education, but will miss the foundational experience he has had at SOU.

### **KACIE RYAN '07**

Kacie Ryan earned a Bachelor of Science in Biology with a Chemistry minor from Southern Oregon University in 2007. While at SOU, Kacie worked in the residence halls and was a member of the National Residence Hall Honorary. Kacie completed a Masters of Education in Curriculum and Instruction with a Middle School Science emphasis in 2008 from Arizona State University. Kacie has used her education as an elementary and middle school teacher for seven years teaching in California and Arizona. During that time, Kacie also wrote science curriculum with the University of Arizona. Kacie is currently a faculty member at Western Governors University, where she teaches educational leadership to practicing teachers throughout the country from her home in Bend, Oregon and serves as the faculty counselor for the school's chapter of Kappa Delta Pi- International Honor Society in Education.

## **Dankook Award for Outstanding Undergraduate Students**

The Dankook Award commemorates more than thirty years of friendship with Dankook University in Seoul, Korea. Each year at commencement, SOU honors its outstanding female and male graduates with this award. This friendship is also recognized during the graduation ceremony at Dankook University, when their outstanding female and male graduates are presented with the Southern Oregon University Award.

The following criteria are used to select the Dankook Award recipients: (1) demonstration of scholarship as evidenced by cumulative GPA at Southern Oregon University; (2) contributions to campus life by playing a leadership role; and (3) evidence of citizenship and character.

### **WILLIAM BABISHOFF '17**

William graduates with a Bachelor of Science in Communication, with an emphasis on Film, Television, and Convergent Media. He is a former radio and television personality who has taken the challenge of obtaining an advanced education later in life, after losing his career due to illness. At SOU, William has participated in several movie and television productions, the SOU film club, and the Siskiyou student newspaper. William's journey was made possible through generous grants and scholarships, including the Osher Re-entry Scholarship, the Olsrud Scholarship, and the Leon Mulling Communication Scholarship, among others. With many thanks to the professors, staff, and people who make Southern Oregon University, William will continue with his dream by becoming a member of the local news media, and will work to promote our beautiful region through film, television, internet, and radio. William is a proud supporter of the Digital Media Center here at SOU, and is a member of Southern Oregon Film and Media, as well as the honor societies Phi Kappa Phi and Phi Theta Kappa.



## **REBEKAH RATCLIFF '17**

As a first-generation student, Rebekah Ratcliff graduates *summa cum laude* with a Bachelor of Art in Sociology and Anthropology, a concentration in Latin American Studies and a Certificate in Nonprofit Management. A recipient of the Schneider Merit Award, and the Bosworth Memorial Scholarship, she has also been recognized by the American Association of University Women and the Friendship Force for her commitment to communities both locally and across the globe. She has worked with organizations supporting minority elementary students in Panama, small-scale coffee cooperatives in Guatemala, social projects in Cuba, and with local initiatives, such as Rogue Valley Farm to School, Raider Alternative Breaks, the Lomakatsi Restoration Project, Habitat for Humanity, and OK Friends. Rebekah served as a research assistant for various projects within the Anthropology Department and has led nonprofit programs in international diplomacy, social advocacy, marginalized community empowerment, and childhood health.

## **Universidad de Guanajuato Award for Outstanding Graduate Student**

Each year, the Universidad de Guanajuato recognizes an outstanding graduate student from the current graduating class. The award winner is nominated by Southern Oregon University faculty members who are familiar with the graduate student's academic work and his/her service to the campus and larger communities. The award winner represents the highest level of academic achievement and service.

## **JARED BROWN '17**

Jared has completed the Master of Music Performance degree with a 4.0 GPA and serving as a Graduate Teaching Assistant in Music Theory/Aural Skills and Percussion. While living in the Rogue Valley, he has been fortunate to work with the students of the Crater Renaissance Academy and Instrumental Music program at the Crater campus in Central Point, Oregon, where students learn about the similarities between different cultures through their respective musical traditions. With music as a catalyst, Jared's goal is to inspire his students to pursue creative, collaborative avenues with the intention of cultivating positive relationships in their community. Jared has been especially nourished intellectually by the efforts of his primary advisor, Dr. Terry Longshore. Terry's care for his students is the prime example of altruism, the model of an educator on which Jared bases his outreach.

## **2017 Distinguished Service and Teaching Awards**

### **DR. VICKI PURSLOW, PROFESSOR OF MUSIC**

Dr. Purslow, Professor of Music, and before that an Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, has a distinctive career with more than 30 years of teaching and administrative experience in higher education. Purslow has served as a faculty senator, President of the Associated Professors of Southern Oregon University, chair of the Student Success Committee, chair of the music program, and chair of the University Planning Committee. Dr. Purslow is a past board member for the Britt Arts and Music Festival, Dragon Family Foundation, and Jackson County Cultural Coalition. Presently, Dr. Purslow is the board chair for Jackson County Fire District 5 and a member of both the Ashland and Talent Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT).

### **DR. LISA CIASULLO, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF MATHEMATICS**

In her 27 years of teaching at SOU, Dr. Ciasullo has made a profound impact on the Math Department. Her colleague, Dr. Dusty Sabo, observes that her class notes are the most shared among the faculty, and you can tell how helpful she is to students from the line outside her door during office hours. While her approach to teaching is very caring and student-centered, she also constantly challenges her students, ensuring that they move on well-prepared for the next level. Wrote one former student, "Dr. Ciasullo possesses the ability to inspire her students to transcend the constraints and formalities of letter grades and degree-seeking, to the domain where knowledge and creativity are the ultimate and supreme intellectual goals."

### **DR. KYLAN DE VRIES, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF SOCIOLOGY, AND GENDER, SEXUALITY AND WOMEN'S STUDIES**

Dr. de Vries has taught at SOU for the past seven years, and, according to his colleague Dr. Brook Colley, demonstrates a rare capacity to deeply engage his students through critical pedagogy while creating inclusive learning environments for diverse groups of students. Dr. de Vries regularly includes transformative learning assignments in his coursework, such as service learning and activist projects. One student wrote, "Kylan is one of the best professors that I have had while at SOU. He makes the material easy to understand and teaches it very effectively. I came in to the class ignorant in so many ways that I didn't even know and Kylan has better prepared me to go in to the world as a person conscious of all gender/sexual identities."

### **DR. BILL GHOLSON, PROFESSOR OF ENGLISH AND WRITING**

In his 23 years of teaching at SOU, Dr. Gholson has played a crucial role in the development of curriculum at both the department and university level. His colleague, Dr. Ed Battistella, noted that Dr. Gholson's commitment to originality and innovation has never waned throughout his career. In his courses he rarely repeats readings, and has recently designed a podcast class from which he is developing the Rogue Collaborative, a teaching project which will allow students to create and produce audio features. Moreover, Dr. Gholson's teaching philosophy goes beyond his immediate classes and aims toward lifelong lessons. He writes: "One of the most important goals of any education should be to teach students how to go on learning, teaching them to teach themselves about how to adapt their abilities to new situations."

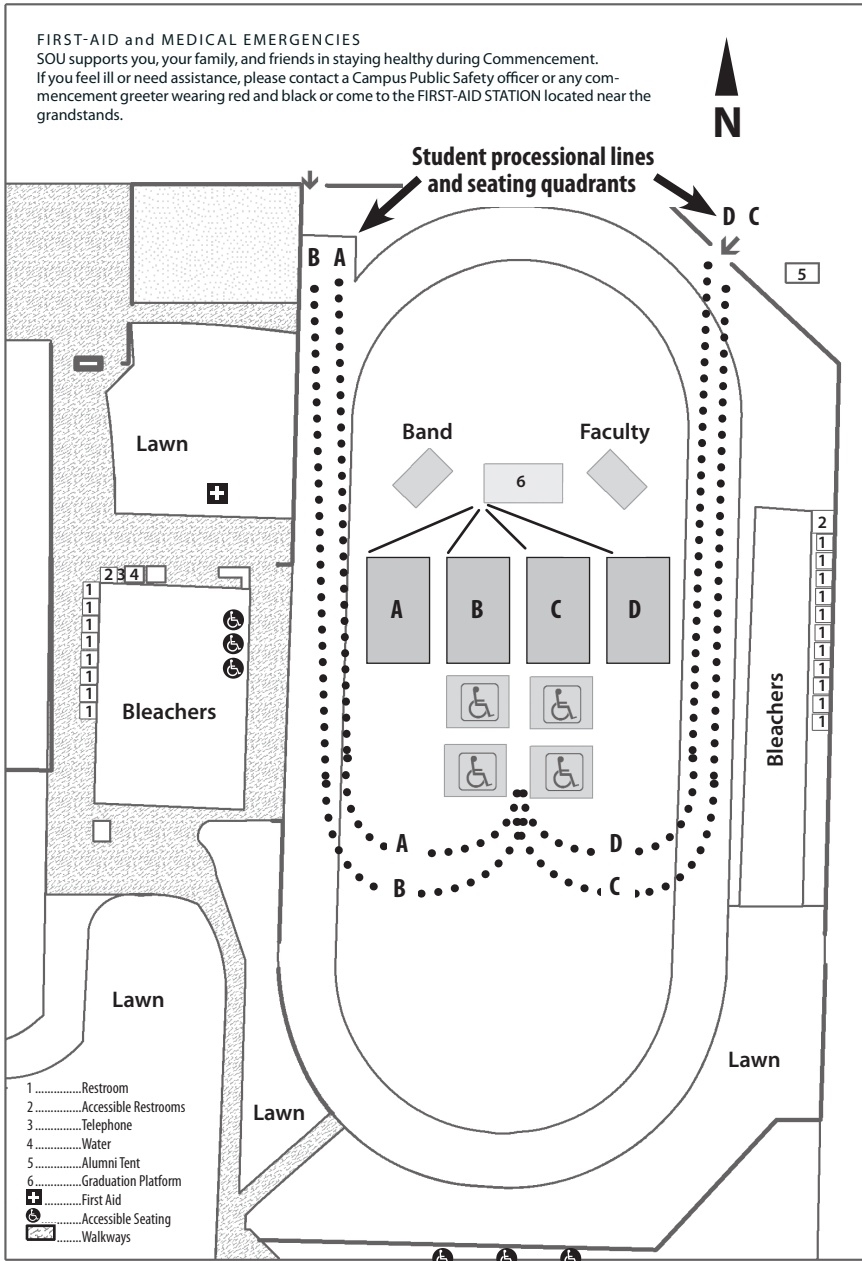
### **DR. ALENA RUGGERIO, PROFESSOR OF COMMUNICATION**

# Honors and Recognition

## **ACCELERATED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM\***

Students wearing stoles with a red collar and black tails with silver printing have completed Southern Oregon University's Accelerated Baccalaureate Degree Program, which enables students to graduate in three years.

## **ALPHA KAPPA DELTA <sup>Δ</sup>**

Alpha Kappa Delta is a national honor society founded in 1920 for the purposes of stimulating scholarship and promoting the scientific study of society. Members must have an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 in sociology course work.

## **ALPHA PHI SIGMA <sup>Σ</sup>**

Alpha Phi Sigma, the national criminal justice honor society, awarded Southern Oregon University a chapter, Sigma Omega Upsilon, in 1997. It is the only criminology or criminal justice honor society in the nation. Requirements for membership include a minimum of 3.0 overall grade point average and a 3.2 grade point average in criminology and criminal justice courses.

## **DELTA ALPHA PI <sup>Π</sup>**

An international honor society for students with disabilities, Delta Alpha Pi has thirty chapters in the United States. The purpose of Delta Alpha Pi is to recognize the academic accomplishments of college and university students with disabilities, to facilitate development of leadership and advocacy skills, and to provide opportunities for members to serve as mentors and role models.

## **DEPARTMENTAL HONORS <sup>®</sup>**

Students graduating with Departmental Honors have completed a required number of honors courses, approved community-based learning activities, and a senior thesis or creative project in their major area.

## **OMICRON DELTA EPSILON <sup>Ε</sup>**

Omicron Delta Epsilon recognizes scholastic achievement in economics and encourages student devotion to the advancement of their science through scholarly effort. Membership is symbolized by gold and bronze cords.

## **OMICRON DELTA KAPPA <sup>^</sup>**

OΔK<sup>®</sup> was the first college honor society of a national scope to give recognition and honor for meritorious leadership and service in extracurricular activities and to encourage development of general campus citizenship. The Southern Oregon University Omicron Delta Kappa Circle recognizes high achievement in: Scholarship, Athletics, Campus/Community Service, Social/Religious Activities, and Campus Government, Journalism, Speech and the Mass Media, and the Creative and Performing Arts.

### **PHI ALPHA THETA** <sup>Ⓞ</sup>

An international honor society founded in 1921, Phi Alpha Theta exists to encourage, stimulate, and maintain excellence in the scholarship of students and faculty. The history society offers members a variety of programs, scholarship awards, and publications. SOU's chapter, Alpha Iota Mu, received its charter in 2001. Students are selected based on excellent scholastic records.

### **PHI KAPPA PHI** <sup>Ⓞ</sup>

Founded in 1897, this national scholastic honor society recognizes superior scholarship in all academic disciplines. Members must be recommended by the faculty of their major department and be in the upper 10 percent of their class.

### **PSI CHI** <sup>✱</sup>

Psi Chi is the national honor society in psychology. It was founded in 1929 for the purpose of encouraging, stimulating, and maintaining excellence in the science of psychology. Members must show active involvement in the study of psychology and be in the upper 35 percent of their class. Membership is symbolized by gold cords.

### **SIGMA XI** <sup>≡</sup>

Sigma Xi, the Scientific Research Society, is an honor for engineers and scientists. Sigma Xi encourages scientific research and promotes public understanding of science and technology.
