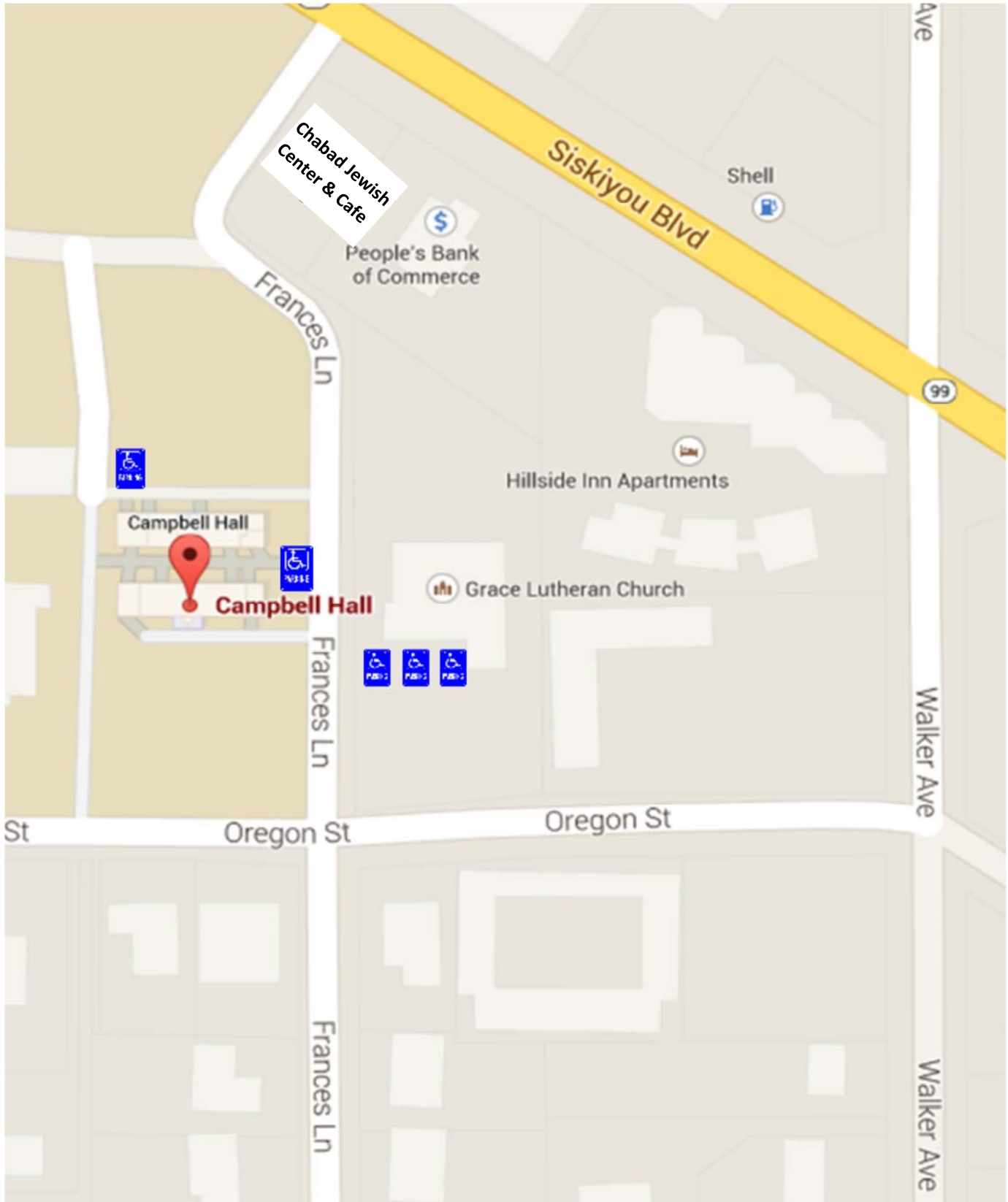


OLLI at SOU Parking Guide

Parking in Ashland for the Campbell Center (a.k.a. Campbell Hall), located at 655 Frances Lane. Free parking is available along the street on Frances Lane, Oregon Street, and Walker Avenue.

OLLI members qualify for free parking in SOU parking lot #16, **but you must do the following to qualify:** Contact SOU Parking Services by email at parking@sou.edu and let them know you are an OLLI member who wishes to park in Lot #16, and provide them with your license plate number(s), the state your license plate was issued by, and your name.

Registrations must be renewed every school year. You do not need to renew it every term. You can register anytime during the school year. No matter when you register, your registration expires at the end of the current school year.

For example: If you sign up in July or August to take Fall term classes that start in September, sometime in August would be a good time to contact Parking Services to register your license plate. Then your registration would automatically remain in effect for the Fall, Winter, and Spring terms. It will expire at the end of the school year, so you have to repeat the process the following August.



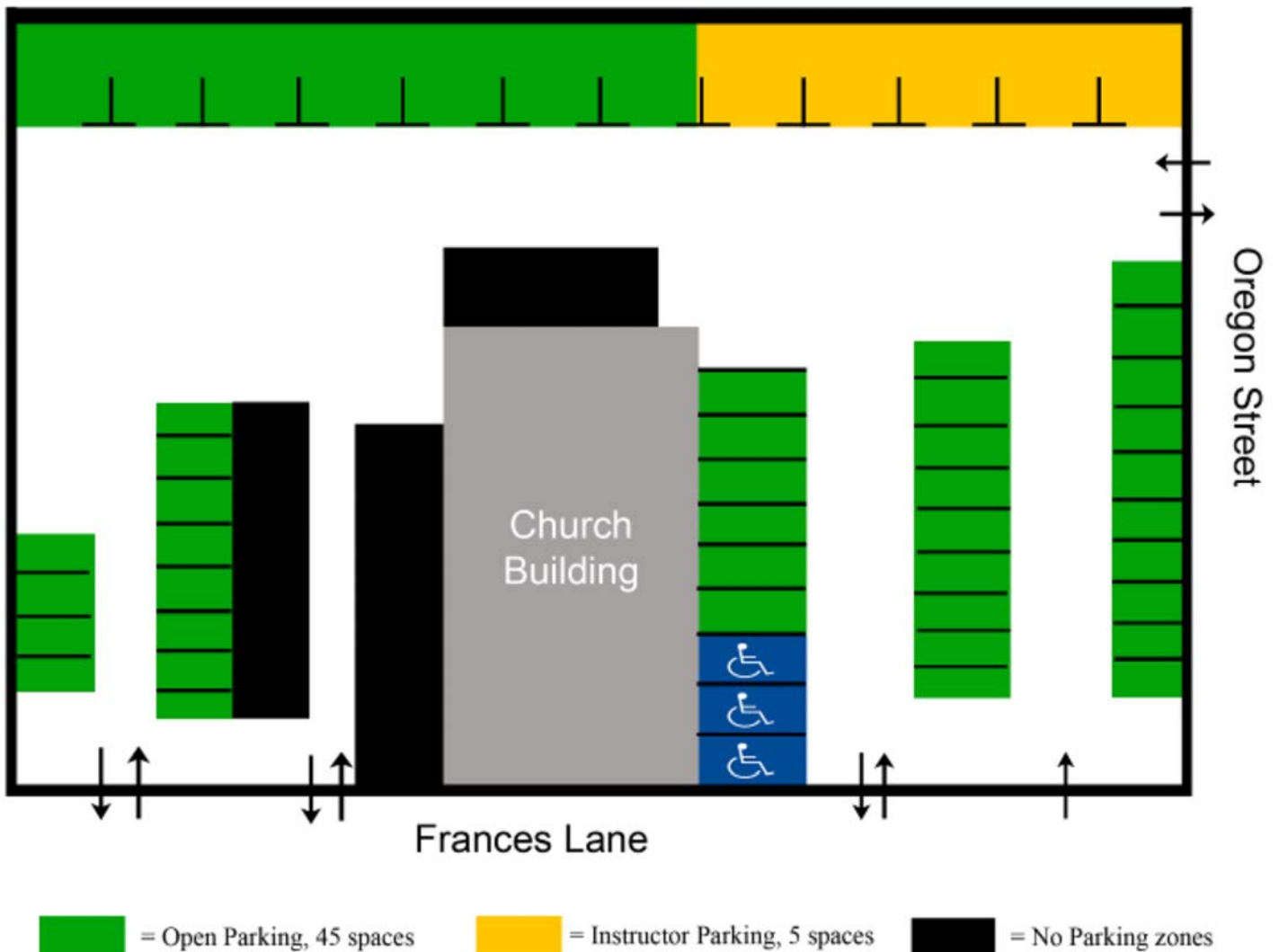

Free parking is available in the Grace Lutheran Church parking lot located directly across the street from the Campbell Center. Please note the “No Parking zones” that are blacked out; these parking spots are reserved for church members only. If you park in one of the church members’ reserved spots, your car may be towed. OLLI will not pay your towing fees or any other fines you may incur if you park in an unauthorized parking spot.

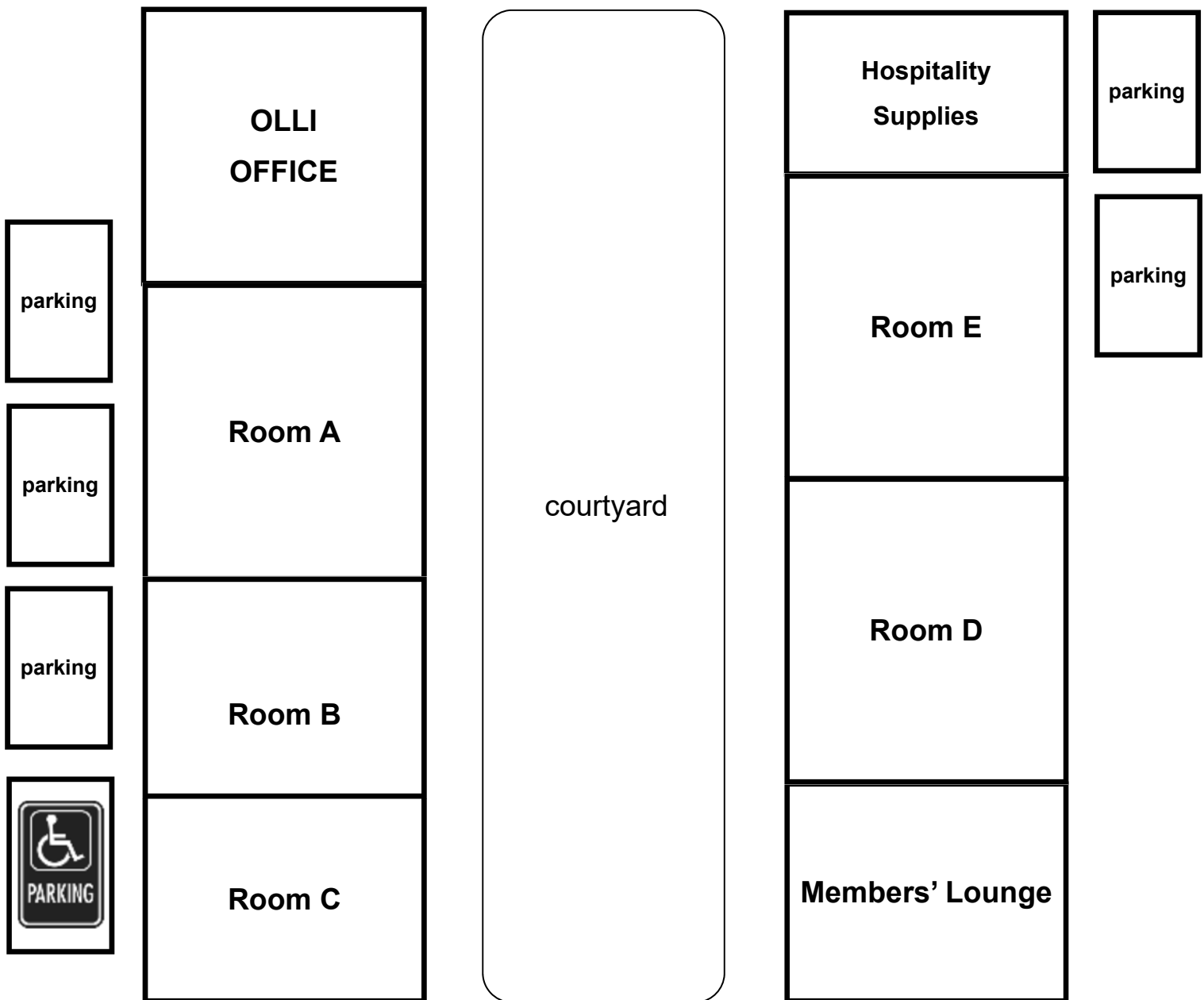
Also, please note the five parking spots located at the top right of the map that are reserved for OLLI instructors only.

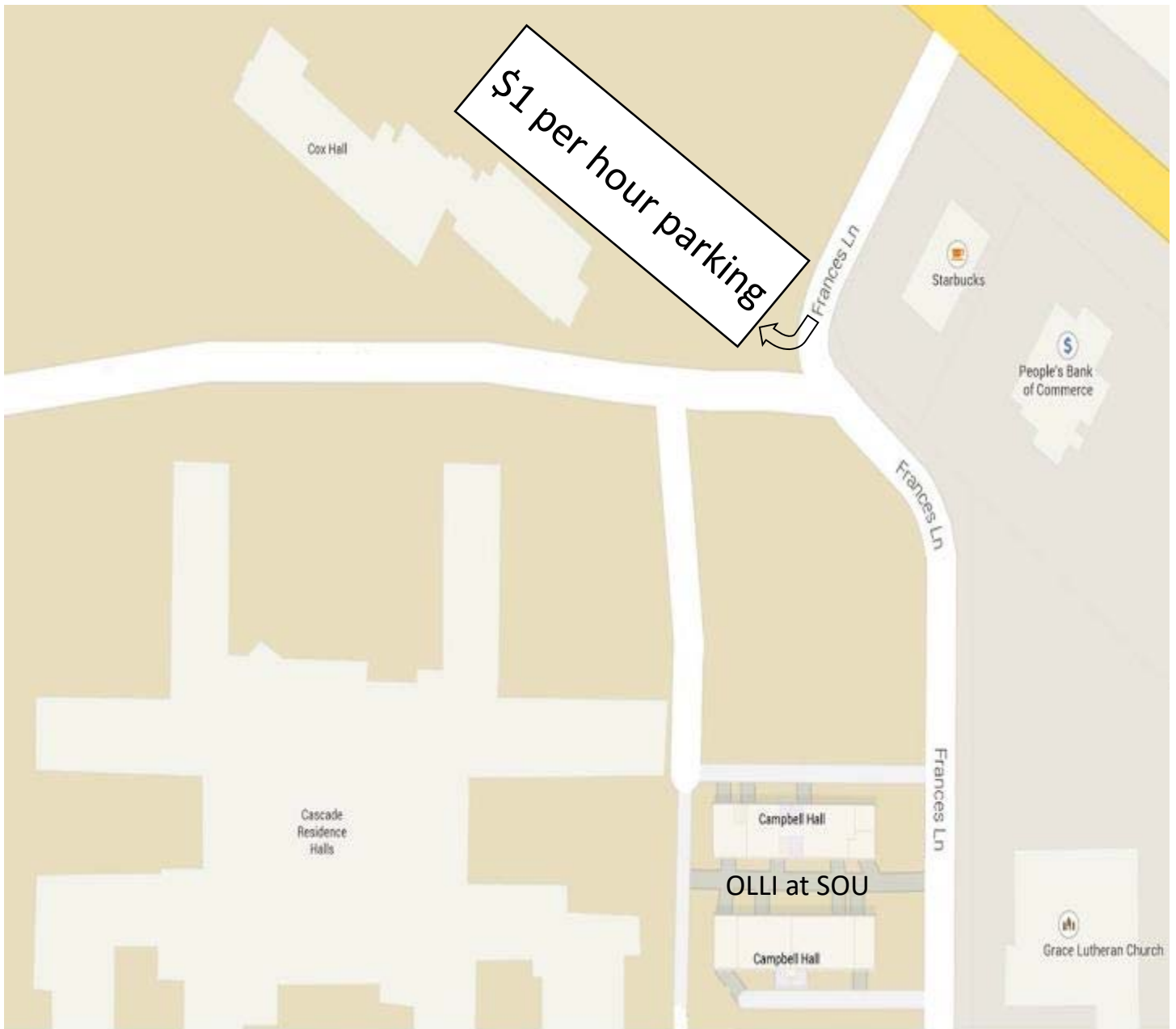

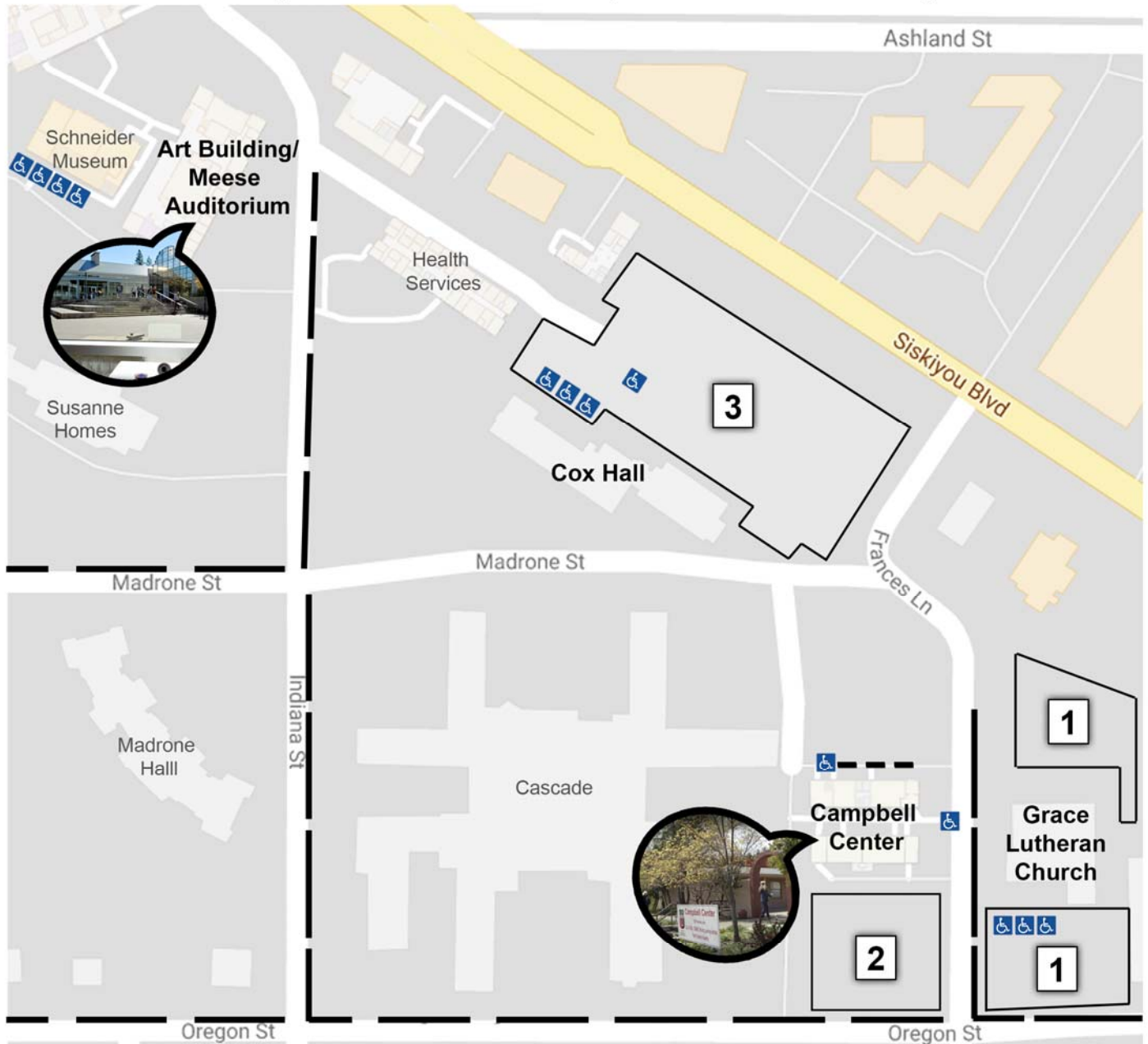
For \$1 an hour (coins and credit cards accepted; no dollar bills), you may park in the Cox Hall parking lot. All parking permits on SOU campus are “virtual,” meaning your license plate number is your permit. After making your payment at the parking meter machine, you enter your license plate number. SOU no longer has any "physical" permits that need to be displayed on the vehicle.



Other options in Cox Hall parking lot: For \$10, you can purchase a parking pass that is good for the entire day. For \$20, you can purchase a parking pass that is good for three days. For \$30, you can purchase a parking pass that is good for an entire week.

1. Grace Lutheran Church

Free parking in OLLI designated areas.

2. SOU Parking Lot #16

Free parking. Contact SOU Parking Services by emailing at parking@sou.edu and provide them with your license plate number.

3. Cox Hall Parking Lot

\$1.00 per hour. Parking permit purchased from lot permit machine. Coins or credit cards accepted.

4. Street Parking

Free parking along streets (marked in thick black dashed lines).



Please note: For handicapped parking in the Cox Hall parking lot and the parking lot adjacent to the Schneider Museum, an SOU parking permit is also required. Contact SOU Parking services by email at parking@sou.edu for more information.

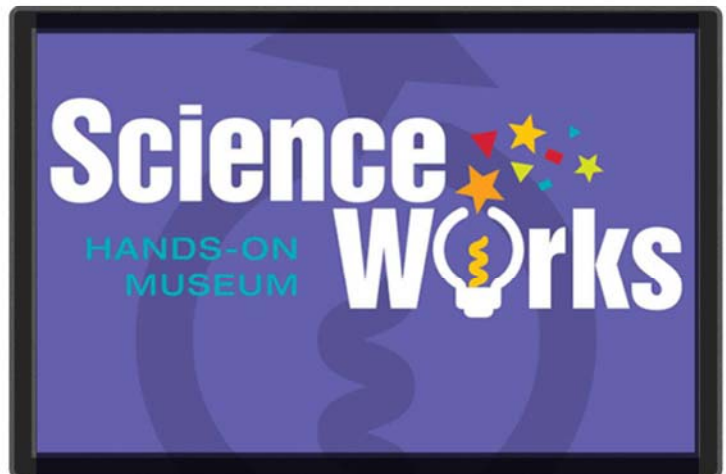

Parking for the ScienceWorks Hands-On Museum, located at 1500 E Main St.



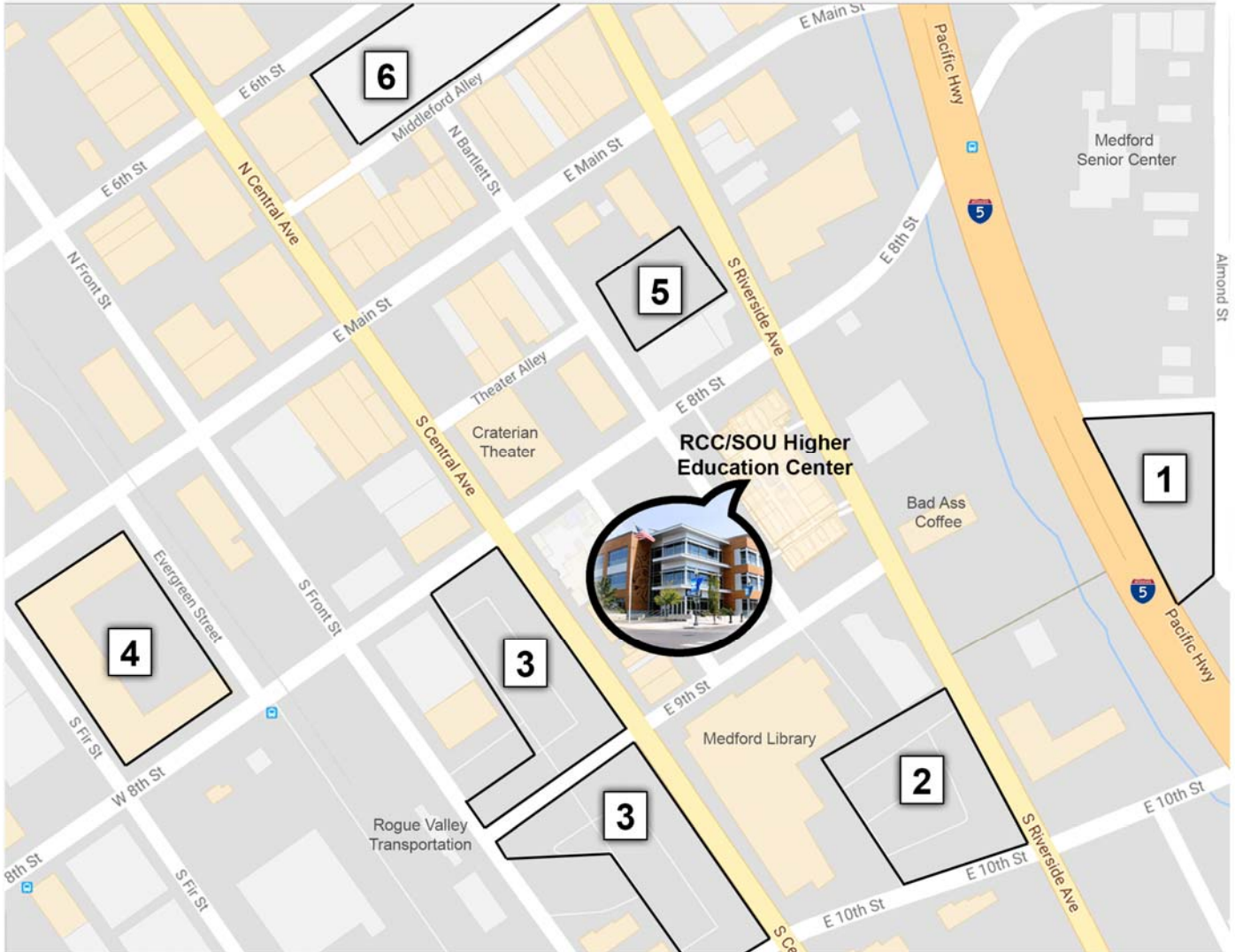
1. ScienceWorks Parking

Ample free parking in a large, paved parking lot.

Parking for the Higher Education Center (H.E.C.), located at 101 South Bartlett Street.



1. Bear Creek South

\$10 per month. Call **541.774.2082** for info.

2. Medford Library

First hour free. Then ¢50 per hour. Pay with coins or credit card at kiosk.

3. S. Central Parking Lots

¢50 per hour first 2 hours, then \$1 per hour. Pay with coins or credit card at kiosk.

4. Evergreen Parking Garage

3 hours free first floor. \$20 per month top floor. Call **541.774.2082** for info.

5. S. Bartlett Parking Lot

¢50 per hour first 2 hours, then \$1 per hour. Pay with coins or credit card.

6. Middleford Parking Garage

2 hours free first floor. \$20 per month top floor. Then ¢50 per hour 2 more hours. Pay with coins or credit card at kiosk. Call **541.774.2082** for info.



With disabled parking placard, park for free with no time limit in any parking spot marked 1 hour or more (not loading zones or 30- or 15-minute parking spaces). Also may park in any parking space marked blue in any parking lot.
